Packing List

IT IS NECESSARY TO BRING ENOUGH CLOTHING FOR A CHANGE EACH DAY. PLEASE LABEL ALL ITEMS WITH THE CAMPER'S INTIALS USING TAGS OR SHARPIE MARKERS. ALL ITEMS MUST BE PROPERLY LABELED TO INSURE SAFE RETURN.

- All prescription medications (In original containers; please do not ration for the week only)
- Any over the counter PRN medications
- Underclothing
- Shirts
- Shorts
- Pants (All campers should bring at least one pair of long pants)
- Sleep clothing/pajamas
- Sandals or Crocs (Not required; swim shoes are allowed in lake and showers as well)
- Tennis shoes (AT LEAST ONE PAIR OF CLOSED TOE SHOES IS REQUIRED; crocs/toe shoes do not count)
- Socks
- Swimsuit (We prefer that girl campers bring one piece swimsuits)
- Rain jacket/Poncho
- Shampoo/Conditioner
- Toothbrush & Toothpaste
- Brush/Comb
- Deodorant
- Soap/Body wash
- Towels and Wash Cloths for the whole 7 days/6 nights (We will not be able to wash them)
- Set of twin sheets, blanket and/or sleeping bags; Beds are frame and mattress only.
- Pillow with pillow cases
- Flashlight
- Sunscreen (Please make sure your camper knows that we will be pushing them to wear this)
- Bug Spray
- Water bottle
- Dirty clothes bag
- Any adaptive equipment used on a daily basis, if needed
- NOTE: We may notify you closer to camp about THEME related items that your camper might want to try and bring as well. Watch your email for details!

WHAT NOT TO BRING:

- CANDY, CHEWING GUM, ANYTHING WITH PEANUT BUTTER/PEANUTS. ALL FOOD AND SNACKS WILL BE HANDLED AND DISTRIBUTED BY OUR KITCHEN STAFF AND/OR COUNSELORS.
- Cell phones, IPods, radios, electronic games. These are a distraction and will not be allowed to be used during the week. Please help us by not allowing your campers to have them. If you have concerns about contacting your camper, please talk to Camp Director about these concerns and about options.
- Jewelry, purses, and/or other accessories of this type. These just don't have a place at camp and we don't want them lost or damaged.
